<b>PRIVILEGED MOTIONS: require immediate action because they involve rights of the group. No other motions can be considered until they are resolved.</b>							
Adjourn the meeting	"I move that we adjourn."	No	Yes	No	No	Majority	No

<b>INCIDENTAL MOTIONS -- arise during debate or other business of the meeting. Must be settled before returning to the business pending.</b>							
Protest breach of rules or conduct	"(I rise to a) point of order!"	Yes	No	No	No	Chair rules	No
Vote on a ruling by the chair	"I appeal the decision of the chair."	Yes	Yes	Yes	No	Majority	Yes
Suspend rules temporarily	"I move to suspend the rules so that..."	No	Yes	No	No	2/3	No
Avoid consideration of improper issue	"I object to consideration of this motion."	Yes	No	No	No	2/3	Yes
Verify a voice vote	"(I call for a) division!"	Yes	No	No	No	Chair rules	No

<b>MAIN MOTIONS: Proposals for final action or to change a decision.</b>
