

**End of Legislative Session Recap – Action Requested - Continued**

<b>Budget</b>	Pass a Fair Budget	
<b>Criminal Justice</b>	HB2373	Expanding eligibility for sealing criminal records and background forgiveness, making it easier for citizens to find employment
	HB3817	Expunge juvenile criminal records so that more people can hold office or obtain a license later in life.
	SB1688	Job opportunities expanded for formerly incarcerated
<b>Economic justice</b>	HB2462	Equal pay for women, and a job applicant cannot be asked about their previous salary history
<b>Education</b>	HB768	The State Charter School Commission cannot override charter decisions made by a local district
	SB1	Evidence-Based funding for schools – Eventually, school districts will receive funding based on the needs of their students.
<b>Election laws</b>	SB1933	Automatic Voter Registration at DMVs etc.
<b>Govt. consolidation</b>	SB3	Expands county consolidation powers, provides co-terminus township dissolution process and other consolidation provisions.
<b>Immigration</b>	SB31	Trust Act – Immigration; sets limits on local police interaction with ICE enforcement
<b>Reproductive Rights</b>	HB40	If Roe v. Wade is overturned, it will not affect Illinois; also will permit abortion to be a covered service under State of Illinois employees’ health insurance and Medicaid
