ROBERTA BORRINO (LWV ROSELLE-BLOOMINGDALE) COMMUNICATIONS

Roberta Borrino is the current co-president of LWV Roselle-Bloomingdale, of which she was a founding member in 2011. She is her League's webmaster and has previously held the position of Voter Service chair both for LWVRB and for LWV Glen Ellyn. Roberta served for 1 year on the LWVIL board very early in her association with the League. When a Communications staff position opened at the state League office, she applied knowing her actions there would be more impactful. She handled the website, social media, member services and the database for 4 years. She ran for public office several times and served 16 years on her local Park District board, holding each of the Executive board positions, including 4 years as president. During her tenure, the park district completed 3 progressively more dynamic master plans. Her other volunteer experience includes 4 years as a Cub Scout leader, 10+ years as both a music parent, and a swim team parent board member. Her professional career spanned 20+ years in Technical Marketing after receiving a BSBA in Marketing from the University of Illinois.
